

Location: All skating programs take place at the **Owen Sound Coliseum**

Cancellation dates: Due to previous arena bookings, skating programs will be cancelled on **Saturday November 1st, 2008**, and **Saturday January 10th, 2009**. In the case of inclement weather, cancellations will be announced on the radio and our website. There will be NO make-up days for weather-related cancellations.

Fundraising books: Fundraising activities are mandatory for all Club Members; ticket books must be paid for at the time of registration. The proceeds of the sales of said books remain with the purchaser

Code of Ethics/rules and regulations: all persons connected with the Owen Sound Skating Club must abide by their Code of Ethics and/or rules and regulations as outlined by Skate Canada and the Owen Sound Skating Club, including SKATERS, PARENTS/VISITORS, COACHES, AND BOARD MEMBERS

Refunds: must be requested by November 15, 2008, IN WRITING, unless accompanied by a Doctor's note; all refund requests are subject to BOARD APPROVAL. A \$10 administration fee plus the Skate Canada fee of \$31.00 will be withheld from all refunds. All refunds will be pro-rated to the date of skater's withdrawal from the program.

Overdue Accounts: Any member whose account is past due will not be permitted to try badges, Skate Canada tests or competitions. NSF cheques will be subject to a **\$50 NSF fee**.

Test envelopes must be to our test chairperson a minimum of one week prior to test day. Male partnering fees are to be paid in advance.
