Cancellation dates: Due to previous bookings, skating programs will be cancelled on **Saturday November 7, 2009, Wednesday December 23, Thursday December 24, Saturday December 26, Wednesday December 30, Thursday December 31, Saturday January 10, 2010, Wednesday February 10, Thursday April 1, Saturday April 3**. In the case of inclement weather, cancellations will be announced on the radio and our website. There will be NO make-up days for weather-related cancellations.

Fundraising books: Fundraising activities are mandatory for all Club Members; ticket books must be paid for at the time of registration. The proceeds of the sales of said books remain with the purchaser.

Code of Ethics/rules and regulations: all persons connected with the Owen Sound Skating Club must abide by their Code of Ethics and/or rules and regulations as outlined by Skate Canada and the Owen Sound Skating Club, including SKATERS, PARENTS/VISITORS, COACHES, AND BOARD MEMBERS

Refunds: must be requested by November 15, 2009, IN WRITING, unless accompanied by a Doctor's note; all refund requests are subject to BOARD APPROVAL. A \$15 administration fee plus the Skate Canada fee of \$31.00 will be withheld from all refunds. Fundraising fees are not refundable. All refunds will be pro-rated to the date of skater's withdrawal from the program.

Overdue Accounts: Any member whose account is past due will not be permitted to try badges, Skate Canada tests or competitions. NSF cheques will be subject to a \$50 NSF fee. Test envelopes must be to our test chairperson a minimum of one week prior to test day. Male partnering fees are to be paid in advance.

Publicity: Throughout the season we will be publishing names and possibly photos of your child. If you would prefer for your child's name not to be included, please let us know immediately, in writing.

Bulletin Board: Please check the board, located outside the music room, for information regarding upcoming events, information, etc.. Also, schedules will be posted on the easel located in the lobby during each session.

Guest Skating: Guest skating may be permitted with advanced permission of the Registrar, Janet Waller-Coture 519-371-6725. Members - \$20 per full Int/Sr session guest skating fee. Non-members - \$30 per full Int/Sr session. **24 hour notice must be given.**
